KID'S CHURCH @ 9:00 AND 11:30 am (grades 1-4)

Children start the morning in graded classrooms with games and activities themed to each week's Bible passage. Then it's on to 'The Pit' for corporate music, teaching, drama, games, and fun all designed to reinforce the theme of the day! Kids end the morning in their graded classrooms for application and discussion time.

CAMPS

- Forest Home Christian Conference Center is WACC's pick for camps. Tucked in the San Bernardino Mountains, it's just a quick 1-1/2 hour ride from church.
- Winter camp is a great place for 4th—6th graders to get away for a weekend of fun as they play, pray and study God's Word. (1st weekend in Mar.)
- Summer Camp finds 5th-6th graders at Adventure Mountain, a safari themed section of camp with activities like skateboarding, photography, radio production, arts and crafts. BASIC TRAINING (grades 5-6)

- 5th and 6th graders start asking tough questions like: What do Christians believe? Why are there so many religions? This 6 week course is designed to answer those questions and more.
