

# JOB DESCRIPTION: Director of 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Grades

**Status:** Part Time: 24 hours per week

**General Position Description:** To lead, disciple, and serve 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and their families at WACC through the implementation of a ministry strategy that inspires 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> graders to follow Jesus and demonstrates Jesus' love to them.

### **Ministry Specific Responsibilities:**

- Cast the vision for a ministry to 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students that is vibrant, relationally-based and aligned with WACC's vision and the vision for the Children's Ministries
- Develop a dynamic leadership team of volunteers through providing resources and training and implementing appreciation strategies
- Create and adapt lessons, activities, and games for Sunday programs at 9:30 am, 11 am, and 5 pm
- Develop an active outreach ministry to 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and their families
- Plan, organize, staff, and coordinate engaging programs where 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students can connect and grow in smaller communities
- Plan and organize serving opportunities for 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students
- Implement policies for the safety and security of children, including but not limited to effective use of check-in and check-out technology
- Plan, organize, and coordinate 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade baptism classes and services
- Plan, staff, implement, and attend camping experiences for upper elementary grades in coordination with Pastor of Children's Ministries
- Use effective modes of communication including emails, Facebook, Twitter, mailings, etc. designed to keep families of 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students engaged and informed of current programs, projects, and opportunities
