



JOB DESCRIPTION: Director of College and Young Adult Ministry

Responsible to: Pastor of Grow Groups Ministry & Coach

Status: Part-time, hourly

General Position Overview: To develop and lead the College and Young Adult Ministry of WACC so that it effectively reaches out and disciples the next generation of followers of Jesus in the Whittier area.

Ministry Responsibilities:

- Develop effective Community Groups for college-aged students and young adults within WACC in collaboration with the Interim Pastor of Grow Groups Ministry & Coach.
- Create and equip a leadership team of college aged students, young adults, and older adults who will help direct the ministry and serve within the church.
- Foster intergenerational connections between college students and young adults with older adults in the church.
- Develop a comprehensive ministry plan that involves seasonal events, retreats, service opportunities, and mission trips for college students and young adults.
- Work together with the High School Pastor to build and maintain a cohesive relationship between the college ministry and the high school ministry to ensure smooth transitions for graduating students between the two ministries.
- Be proactive in keeping the College and Young Adult Ministry in alignment with the mission of WACC and its core values.
- Oversee budget and expenditures for the College and Young Adult Ministries.

Qualifications:

- Strong personal relationship with Jesus Christ as evidenced by spiritual maturity and a close daily walk with Him, including a vision for college/young adult ministry consistent with WACC's mission statement and core values.
- Be committed to the theological stance of the WACC, Converge Worldwide and supportive of the ministry of the Converge Southwest District.
- Preferably, a college graduate with seminary education or equivalent experience and ministry training.
- Experience leading a successful ministry team.
- Good relational and organizational skills.
- Have the maturity to handle counseling issues appropriately.
- Knowledge and understanding of the special needs of college students and young adults in the culture of the Whittier Area.

Working Church Staff and Volunteer Relationships:

- Report directly to the Pastor of Grow Groups Ministry & Coach.
- Develop and be responsible for meetings with volunteers and/or support staff as needed.
- Be a team player with other department leads through active participation in meetings and by developing relationships that are mutually supportive on both a professional and personal level
- Participate in worship services at WACC, meetings, retreats and conferences as requested by the Pastor of Grow Groups Ministry & Coach, the Executive Pastor of Ministries, and the Senior Pastor.
- Participate in Senior Pastor designated “all-in” church wide (volunteer) events (i.e.: Easter, Christmas, Serve, VBS) by serving in a ministry outside your own area
- Minister in partnership with the Grow Groups Team.
- Be informed of and function within the guidelines outlined in the WACC Policy and Personnel Manuals.

Benefits and Compensation:

- Salary and benefits will be reconsidered each year by the Salary Review Team
- Insurance coverage, retirement, vacation, medical and other benefits are described and detailed in the WACC Personnel Policy Manual
- This is a part-time position, 15 hours per week.
