General Position Overview: Provides direct oversight to production and technical staff, as assigned

by the Pastor of Creative Arts.

Ministry Responsibilities:

• Oversee audio/visual technical support of worship services, including rehearsals.

- Provide front of house (FOH) engineering each weekend
- Oversee the creation and implementation of visual media used in worship services and allchurch events.
- Train or provide training for volunteers and staff in use of audio/visual equipment throughout the campus.
- Assist in leading, recruiting, and training all live production volunteer team and staff members.
- Provide fast and effective solutions to all AVL hardware and software difficulties on campus in a prompt and efficient manner.
- Assess future technology needs and works with the Pastor of Creative Arts to implement purchase strategies and timelines.
- Oversee and be responsible for budgets and administration for Technical Arts.
- Drive initiatives from conception to completion, working with product owners and key staff members while contributing to long-range strategy planning.
- Provide trained technical personnel for non-church events such as weddings and memorial services.
- Consultancy and technical support to other ministries.

Education/Experience:

- College degree with specialization in related field or equivalent training program is preferred.
- Three to five years of experience in the following areas:
 - Large venue format as lead FOH engineer/technical director
 - Engineering and troubleshooting DMX lighting
 - Overseeing camera operations in a live, multi-camera environment

- Detailed knowledge of intelligent, theatrical, LED, and DMX processing of lighting.
