The Children's Pastor will be responsible for the pastoring of the children and their families, the development of the volunteer leadership team, and the implementation of a ministry strategy that inspires wonder about God and builds a foundation of faith that will last a lifetime.

The Children's Ministries at WACC is a vibrant ministry that serves hundreds of kids each week. It's an environment where kids experience God, not just learn about Him, in a relevant, relational way. The Children's Ministry at WACC serves children from infants through sixth grade, and the staff is currently writing their own custom curriculum for first through sixth grade.

The person must possess strong interpersonal skills, time management skills, team building skills, and must be an excellent communicator.
